Roll Call

- a. Carla Street discussed the Military Appreciation Day Celebration that is to take place on May 18, 2019. Police Chief Sanchez wanted to know where specifically the alcohol and the consumption of the alcohol will take place. The Beer garden will be off to the side of the bandstand along Park Ave. The area will be fenced off like last year and there will be gates where staff will check ID. Those who are drinking will not be able to leave the area with the alcohol, including the band members. All selling, consumption and disposing of the trash for this area will stay within the fenced area. The staff will be checking ID in addition to using a wrist band that says over 21. Security and traffic control will be provided by VFW.
- b. Discussion with SLPD regarding Special Event Permits and Proposed Ordinance Discussion regarding other cities charging to use facilities and rates for certain days and whether or not city employees are required to work the event. Permits and rental rates will help the city cover the costs of events that occur within the city, including city employees and their wages to work all events. An application process will let the city know what the event is, what the event entails and who and what will be needed to make the event a success.

- c. Discussion with Spirit Lake Park and Rec. Assistant Mary, regarding fees for Park and Rec.

Interest is in keeping all events local and getting more kids involved. Increase some fees regarding events Park and Rec puts on as rates have not been increased in years. Costs will cover the use of fields, field maintenance, purchase of equipment, etc. Prices are comparable to other city costs. A flat fee will be charged whether you are a resident or not. Rates concerning weekday versus weekend for sports teams and rec center rentals.
